The shelter provides a safe, home-like environment to work on financial, health and housing goals alongside 24 hours/day caring staff.

Who is eligible?

- Homeless
- Willing to engage in regular case management meetings.

Help provided:

- Essential supplies and meals
- Housing assistance
- Security & first-month rent, if qualified.
- Employment or education
- Daily living skills
- Medication and symptom management
- Mental health and/or substance use support
- Referrals to clinicians and specialists
- Gym membership

SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

We operate affordable apartment units that are available on a first-come, first-serve basis as vacancies occur.
